Culturally Inclusive Teaching and professional learning

This is a self-paced 4-hour MyPL course to support teachers develop and implement culturally inclusive teaching strategies and practices to enable all students to participate successfully in our culturally diverse society.

Engaging Culturally Diverse Communities

This is a 5-hour MyPL training course targeted to school leaders and staff who want to develop their skills in effectively communicating and engaging with their parents/carers and community members from culturally, linguistically, and religiously diverse communities.

Further professional learning

<u>Anti- Racism – foundations for change</u> – This is a 45-minute MyPL course that aims to set firm foundations for all staff to prevent and respond to racism. It is framed around the idea that to eliminate racism we need to deepen our understanding of its impact and commit to anti-racism actions to prevent it.

<u>Anti-bullying interventions in schools</u> – This is a 2-hour MyPL course allows educators to engage with contemporary literature on anti-bullying interventions and connect it to their own practice.

<u>Community Engagement Module 1</u> – This is a 1-hour MyPL course that promotes the value of community engagement in supporting the progress, achievement and wellbeing of students.

<u>Facing up to Racism</u> – This is a 3.5-hour MyPL course that deepens awareness of racism and how it manifests and operates. It also explores ways to challenge bias, stereotypes, and racism and develop an anti-racist stance to combat the impact of racism on student wellbeing and learning outcomes.

<u>Restorative Practice</u> – This is a 3-hour MyPL course. It provides a foundational understanding of whole school teaching and learning approaches that encourage supportive and respectful behaviour.

<u>School Excellence – Authentic Community Engagement</u> – This is a 1-hour MyPL course that aims to develop a foundational understanding of authentic community engagement, in relation to the School Excellence cycle.
