| Independent | Oran Park Anglican College | ORAN PARK | Construction of a two storey building for general learning areas and breakout spaces, student amenities, administration facilities, sick bay, staff offices, staffroom, footpaths and covered walkways. | \$1,100,000 |
| Independent | St Mark's Coptic Orthodox College | WATTLE GROVE | Construction of a two storey building comprising general learning areas, Library/Research Centre, flexible seminar spaces and study rooms, administration offices, amenities, multipurpose hall/gym and storage areas. | \$800,000 |

| Independent | The Riverina Anglican College | WAGGA WAGGA | Construction of a new STEM facility with science labs and associated general learning areas, science prep and storerooms, an outdoor learning area, staff room, amenities. | \$1,000,000 |
| Independent | Thomas Hassall Anglican College | MIDDLETON GRANGE | Construction of extension to the existing junior school building to provide general learning areas, resource space, breakout area and covered verandah. | \$500,000 |
| Independent | Wahroonga Adventist School | WAHROONGA | Construction of a three storey building comprising general learning areas with shared learning spaces and amenities. | \$1,000,000 |
| Independent | Warakirri College, Blacktown | FAIRFIELD | Refurbishment and fitout of existing classroom as a science laboratory and prep room with a chemical storage facility as well as the relocation of an existing reception area to allow access to science lab. | \$125,000 |
| Independent | Wollondilly Anglican College | TAHMOOR | Construction of a two storey facility comprising general learning areas, central resource area, staff offices, storerooms, covered verandas and pupil amenities. | \$900,000 |
