

NSW Government Building Grants Assistance Scheme (BGAS) for Non-Government Schools - 2018/19 Projects

Notes: Funding for the BGAS for non-government schools is provided through Block Grant Authorities (BGAs). The BGAs recommend projects for NSW BGAS funding in accordance with the BGAS guidelines. The NSW BGAS grant amounts allocated to the non-government schools listed below are as at 31 May 2021. The NSW BGAS grant amount and project details are subject to change due to variations and withdrawals of projects over time. The NSW BGAS grant amounts may include funding from interest accrued and withdrawn projects over time.

Construction of a secondary school areas to include general and specialised learning areas for hospitality, music and technical and applied studies, withdrawal spaces, stairs, lifts, storage areas, a verandah, a covered outdoor area, student amenities including accessible amenities and building services. | \$3,600,000 |
| Catholic | St Lucy's School | WAHROONGA | Special school. Construction includes general learning areas, a covered outdoor learning area, student amenities, verandahs, basement carpark and covered circulation area. | \$3,900,000 |
| Catholic | St Luke's Arrunga | MARSDEN PARK | New special school. Construction of a high needs unit to include general learning areas, administration offices, interview room, meeting room, staff training and lounge, accessible amenities, kitchen, laundry, covered outdoor area, verandah, storage area and building services. | \$2,400,606 |
| Catholic | St Luke's Catholic College (Primary) | MARSDEN PARK | Construction of a new primary school building comprising general learning areas, break out areas, student amenities, a verandah, stairs and circulation areas. Construction on another building to include the main covered outdoor learning area, verandahs and stairs. | \$530,060 |

Construction on another building to include the main covered outdoor learning area, verandahs and stairs. | \$2,598,516 |
| Independent | Australian Christian College - Marsden Park | RIVERSTONE | Construction of a three level Building consisting of fourteen General Learning Areas, reception/staff and admin area, student and staff amenities and storage areas. | \$1,950,000 |

| Independent | St Patrick's College Campbelltown | CAMPBELLTOWN | Refurbishment of the northern wing of an existing building to provide a new purpose built technical and applied studies area with five specialist learning spaces and associated materials and project storage areas. | \$500,000 |
| Independent | St Peter's Anglican College | BROULEE | Construction of a design and technology facility | \$300,000 |
| Independent | St Philip's Christian College - Cessnock | NULKABA | Construction a two story senior studies building with 12 general learning areas, break out and collaborative spaces and outdoor learning terraces. | \$650,000 |
| Independent | Wellington Christian School | WELLINGTON | Refurbishment of existing space to create general learning areas, communications room, external decking and temporary ramping for future stages. | \$225,000 |
