

The Resource Allocation Model (RAM) in 2024

For NSW public schools, the table below shows the 2024 RAM funding.

The 2024 RAM funding represents the total 2024 funding for the 4 equity loadings and the 3 base allocation loadings, a total of 7 loadings. The equity loadings are socio-economic background, Aboriginal background, English language proficiency and, low-level adjustment for disability. The base loadings are location, professional learning, and per capita. Changes in school funding are the result of changes to student needs, student enrolments and/or allocation methodology updates.
