


## Compound sentences

## A compound sentence:

- has 2 or more independent clauses
- joins ideas of equal importance
- connects independent clauses using coordinating conjunctions, semicolons or conjunctive adverbs.





## Compound sentences

## Punctuating a compound sentence

When writing a compound sentence that:

- 1 contains a coordinating conjunction, a comma is used at the end of the first independent clause.
- 2 does not contain a coordinating conjunction, a semicolon is used between the 2 independent clauses.
- 3 contains a conjunctive adverb, a semicolon is used. A semicolon is used at the end of the first independent clause, and a comma is used after the conjunctive adverb.
