Action Taken	Prosecution action against Ms Daoud for: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• two offences of failing to ensure adequate supervision of children - section 165(3) of the <i>Children (Education and Care Services) National Law (NSW)</i>; and• one offence of failing to ensure that every reasonable precaution was taken to protect children from harm and from any hazard likely to cause injury – section 167(3) of the <i>Children (Education and Care Services) National Law (NSW)</i>.
Date of conviction	7 February 2020
Sentence	Convicted at Bankstown Local Court and fined a total of \$750

Proven offence:

Ms Daoud, in her capacity as a family day care educator:

- failed to adequately supervise the children in her care by leaving them at the family day care residence with a person who was not a family day care educator assistant; and
- failed to ensure that she took every reasonable precaution to protect a child from harm and from hazard likely to cause injury in that the 22 month old child was left in an environment where he was not adequately supervised, was able to exit the residence undetected and was able to walk alone to the intersection of a major road.
