Reason	The Regulatory Authority has substantiated a breach of Section 167(3) of the Education and Care Services National Law - Offence to relating to protection of children from harm and hazards
The Regulatory Authority has accepted an enforceable undertaking on the following terms:	<p>The educator will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Ensure as a family day care educator that no child under the age of two years is registered to be educated and cared for in my family day care residence or venue.</li> <li>(b) Abide by all policies and procedures at an education and care service, and, in particular, those pertaining to the protection of children from harm and hazards, including safe sleep practices.</li> <li>(c) Will continue to undertake training and provide evidence to the Department, every 12 months of ongoing development in relation to Division 1A – Sleep and Rest, until July 2027.</li> <li>(d) Will ensure that I advise the approved provider and nominated supervisor of any education and care service that I may be registered at, of the existence and the terms of this undertaking. I understand this undertaking will be in force for no less than three years from the date of acceptance by the Regulatory Authority.</li> <li>(e) Will ensure that for a period of three years, I will notify the Department within 3 days of me being engaged, registered or deregistered from any education and care service.</li> </ul>
