Reason	The Regulatory Authority has substantiated breaches of sections 165(3) and 167(3) of the Education and Care Services National Law.
The Regulatory Authority has accepted an enforceable undertaking on the following terms:	<p>The educator will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) not undertake to seek employment or to be otherwise be involved in the provision of a family day care service. b) not undertake to seek employment or to be otherwise involved in the provision of a centre-based education and care service without: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. first <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. engaging in training in recognised safe sleep practices, as indicated by Red Nose Australia; and ii. engaging in training in the adequate supervision of children in an education and care service; b. second: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. notifying the Regulatory Authority of any proposed employment or involvement in an education and care service; and ii. providing evidence of the training to the Regulatory Authority; and iii. providing further submissions to the Regulatory Authority as to why she would not pose an unacceptable risk to children if she were allowed to remain at the education and care service premises; or to provide education and care to children; and c) seek the consent of the Regulatory Authority to any proposed employment or involvement in an education and care service.
