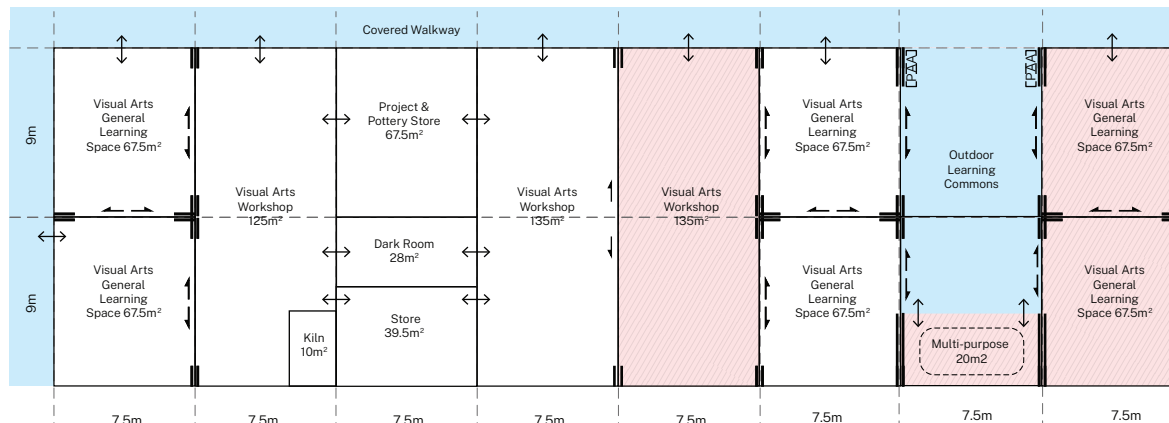
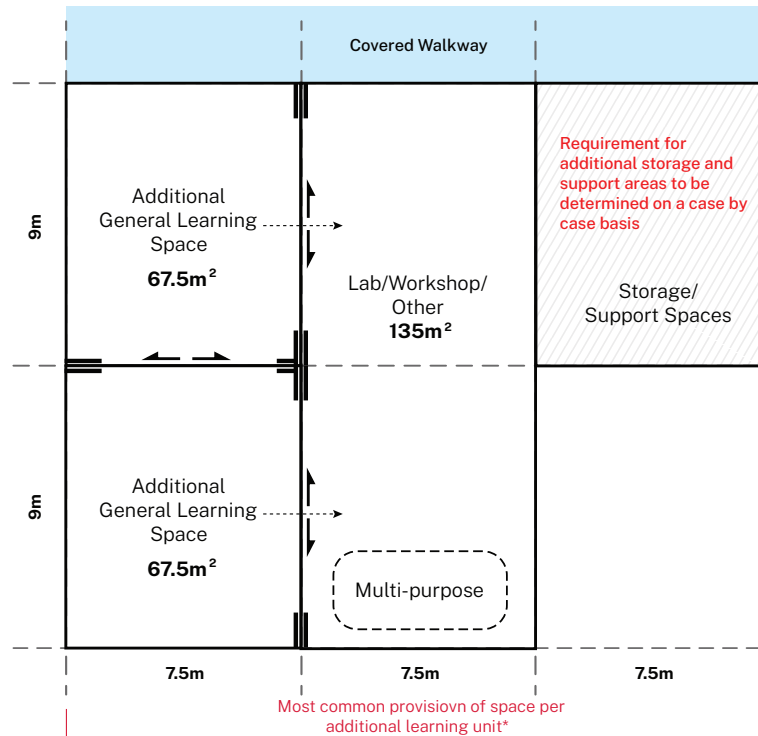


Additional Learning Hubs Secondary School (Medium/Stream 9)

Three of the following additional learning units may be chosen on top of the standard accommodation schedule, to suit the educational requirements of the school:

- Science Learning Hub*
 - Visual Arts Learning Hub*
 - Wood and/or Metal Technology Learning Hub*
 - Food and/or Textiles Learning Hub*
 - Health and PE Learning Hub*
 - Performing Arts/Movement Learning Hub*
 - Lecture Theatre
 - Vocational Education and Training (VET) and Trade Training Centres (TTC) in schools may also be provided as required, including focus areas such as music and entertainment, agriculture, horticulture, rural operations, land management and conservation, hospitality, kitchen operations, construction pathways courses (general construction, mechanical, electrical, plumbing), automotive workshop, retail and business, health and community services and transport, postal and warehousing.
- Designs for these learning hubs vary and are to be developed on a case by case basis.

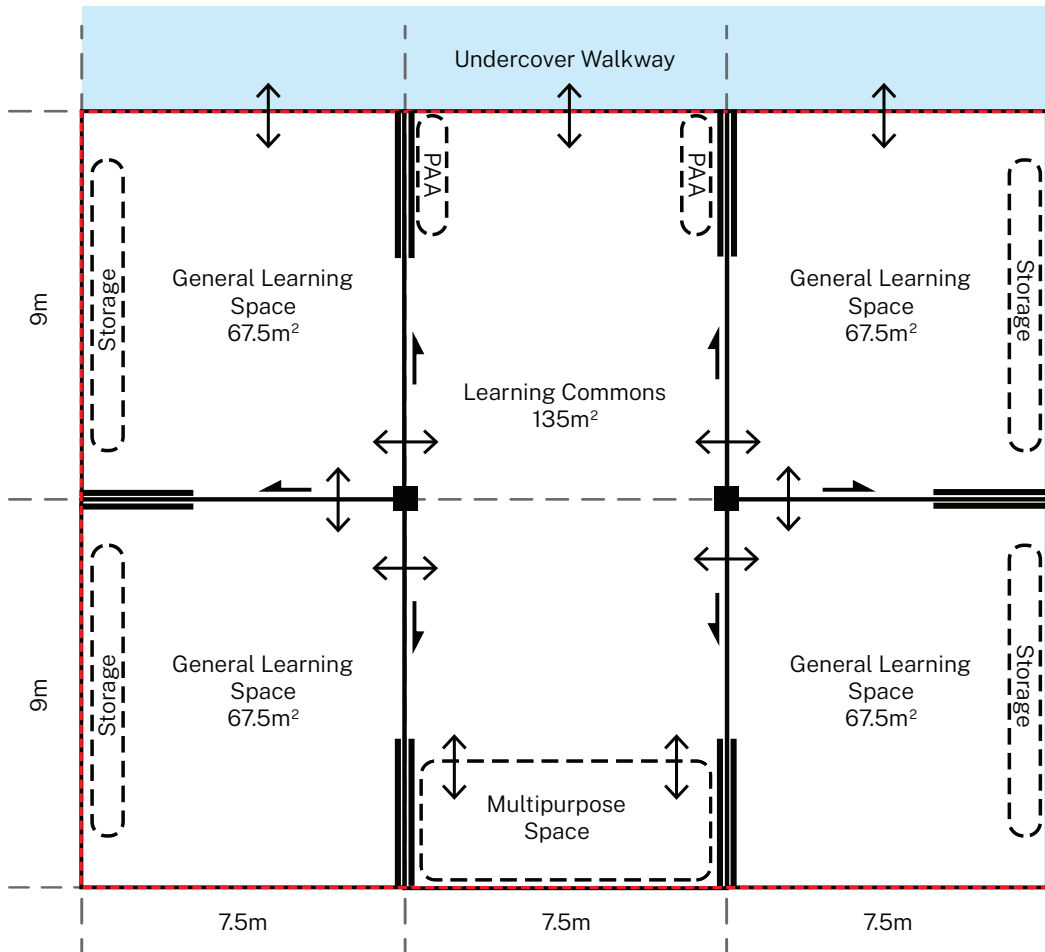


High School - Science - stream 9 (medium) +additional VA learning unit
