### Skills to develop

The central goal of learning a modern language is to learn to communicate in the target language. This includes applying your knowledge of vocabulary, grammar and language structures, as well as using culturally appropriate language.



### Interacting

Interacting is done primarily through spoken language.

Exchange information and opinions in a range of familiar contexts, using culturally appropriate language

- socialise with peers
- share information about your own and others' personal worlds
- say how you feel
- explain what you like and dislike, with reasons
- ask questions and describe things you do
- use a range of communication strategies, such as asking for help when you don't understand

Interpret and respond to information, opinions and ideas in spoken, written and multimodal texts

- listen to, read and view information, opinions and ideas in texts
- develop and use comprehension strategies to show you understand main ideas and supporting details in texts
- respond in English or the target language to main ideas and details in texts
- demonstrate understanding of the context, purpose and audience of predictable texts



### Understanding texts

Create a range of spoken, written and multimodal texts for familiar purposes

- create informative texts to describe and share information about yourself and your personal world
- create imaginative texts
- use familiar text features
