# Supporting business outcomes for Aboriginal people in NSW

The Aboriginal Business Advisory Initiative (ABAI) is funded by the NSW Government and provides business advisory services to Aboriginal people and Aboriginal business owners.

The ABAI supports Aboriginal businesses by building capacity through greater connectivity to NSW Government Procurement, supporting business start-up, encouraging business expansion and providing access to training and job creation.

The ABAI achieves these objectives by:

- Providing local and culturally appropriate business coaching and advice to support start-ups and growth of small to medium enterprises;
- Supporting business growth through training, mentoring and innovation.
- Providing a professional referral pathway to wrap around support services;
- Increasing alignment and connectivity to broader Government initiatives; and
- Increase the capability of Aboriginal owned businesses to gain NSW Government procurement opportunities.
