- Opportunity Hubs provide support for Aboriginal students in years 5 to 12
- Engage Aboriginal students and their families throughout their schooling journey
- Holistic approach to mentoring, focusing on academic, well-being, cultural and career pathway outcomes
- Support School Based Apprenticeships & Traineeships (SBAT)
- Supporting schools to strengthen relationships between Aboriginal students, families and the wider community
- 12 month post school support for school leavers transitioning into further education and/or training
