

Application for approval to teach an additional subject on the basis of teaching experience

Experienced teachers may be eligible for approval to teach in an additional subject area on the basis of verified successful teaching experience.

All subjects within the secondary Key Learning Areas of Technological and Applied Studies (TAS), Human Society and Its Environment (HSIE), and Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PD/H/PE) are available for additional approval via the teaching experience pathway. Additional approval via the teaching experience pathway is also available for Infants (K-2) and Primary (Year 3-6).

Eligibility:

To be eligible, a teacher must:

- Hold a current approval to teach with the NSW Department of Education.
- Have been granted accreditation with the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA).
- Have completed a minimum of two years full-time relevant teaching experience or equivalent part-time or casual teaching experience in NSW public schools in the last five years, in the subject area for which they are seeking additional approval.
- Have their teaching experience verified by their supervisor and principal, along with evidence to demonstrate their skills and experience teaching the relevant NESA syllabus.

The teachers should use the below **Australian Professional Standards for Teachers** as a guide when providing evidence to their supervisor and principal to demonstrate their knowledge, practice and professional engagement in the subject area for which they are seeking additional approval:

- Standard 2: Know the content and how to teach it.
- Standard 3: Plan for and implement effective teaching and learning.
- Standard 5: Assess, provide feedback and report on student learning.
- Standard 6: Engage in professional learning.

Teaching experience guidelines:

A minimum of two years full-time relevant teaching experience (406 days) or equivalent part-time or casual teaching experience in NSW public schools is necessary within the last five years.

- To gain primary (Year 3-6) teaching approval, experience in teaching English and mathematics and at least one other primary key learning area (KLA) is required. Experience in teaching across more than one stage is desirable.
 To gain infants (K-2) teaching approval in addition to primary (Year 3-6), experience must include at least one full term teaching Stage 1.
- To gain **infants** (K-2) teaching approval, experience in teaching across Kindergarten, Year 1 or Year 2 is desirable.
- To gain approval for a Year 7-8 subject, experience in teaching across both Years 7 and 8 is desirable.
- To gain approval for a **Year 7-10 subject**, experience in teaching at least one full year course for Years 7 or 8, and one full year course for Years 9 or 10 is required.
- To gain approval for a **Year 11-12 subject**, experience in teaching at least one full Year 11 preliminary course and one full Year 12 HSC course is required.
- To gain approval for a **Year 7-12 subject**, experience in teaching at least one full Year 11 preliminary course and one full Year 12 HSC course is required. Experience teaching Year 7-10 classes is desirable.
