

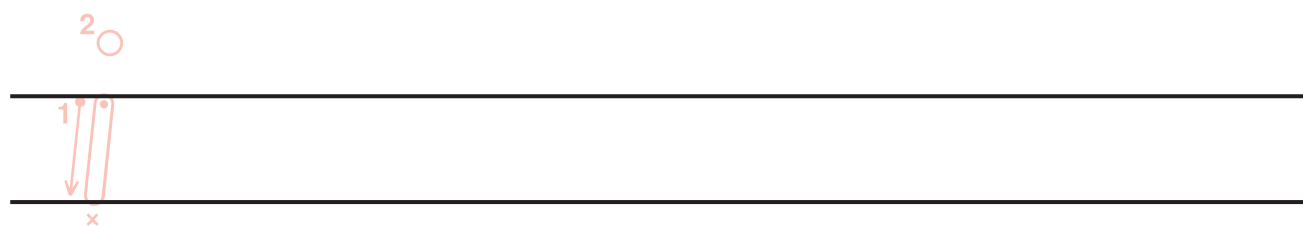
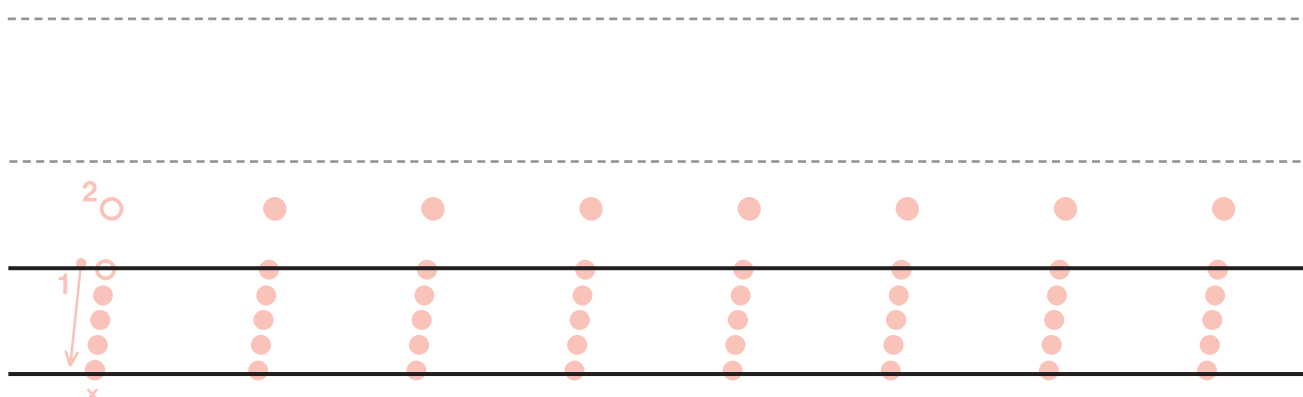
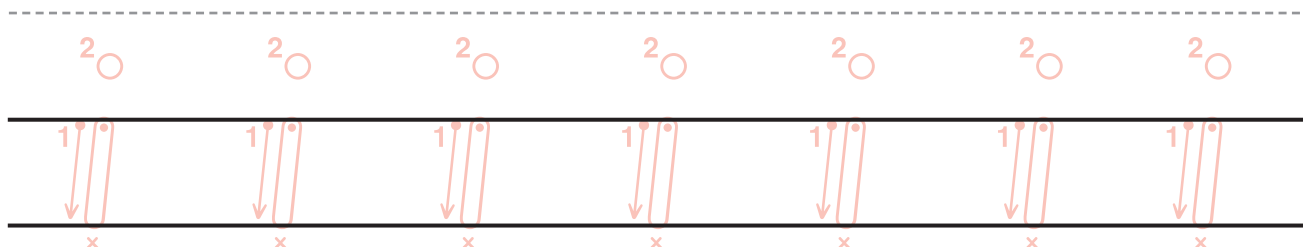
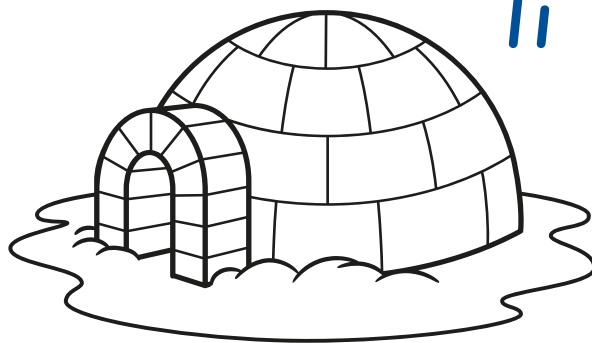
# Lower case i

The lower case 'i' is a short letter.

We make a little line and one small dot on top.

Example mnemonic: Down, dot!

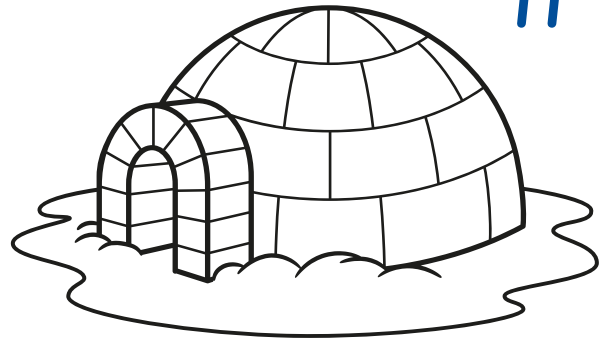


# Upper case I

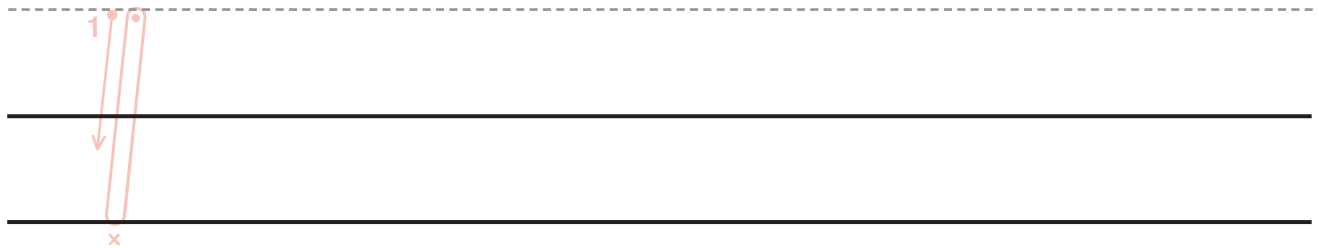
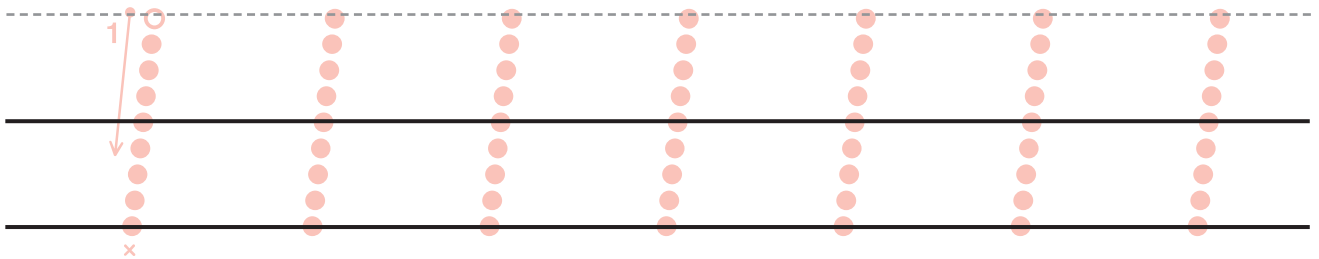
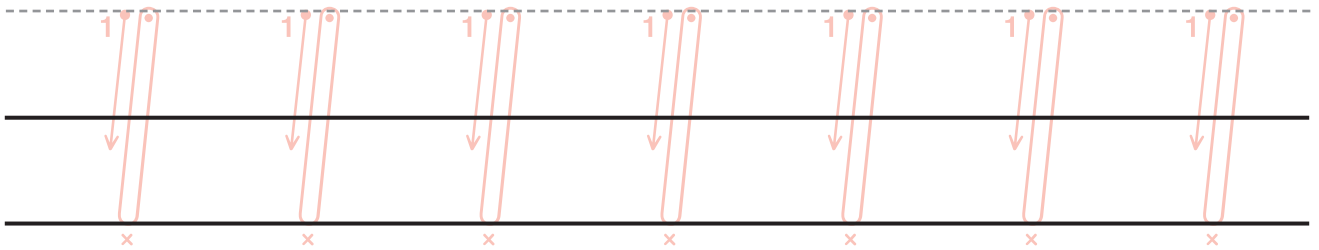
The upper case 'I' is a tall letter.  
We make one straight line.

Example mnemonic: Straight down!

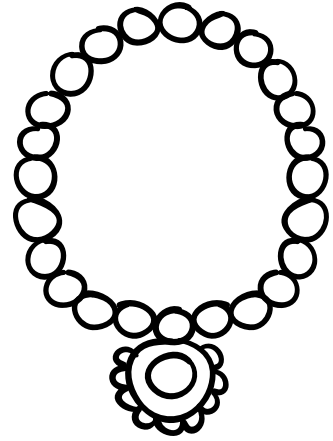


# Lower case n

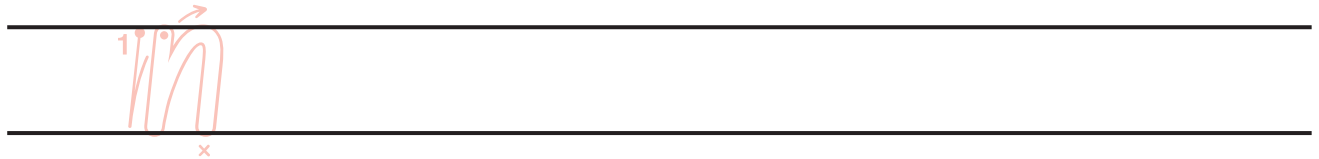
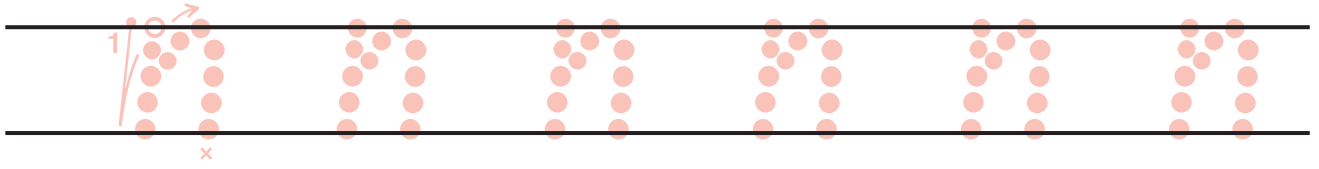
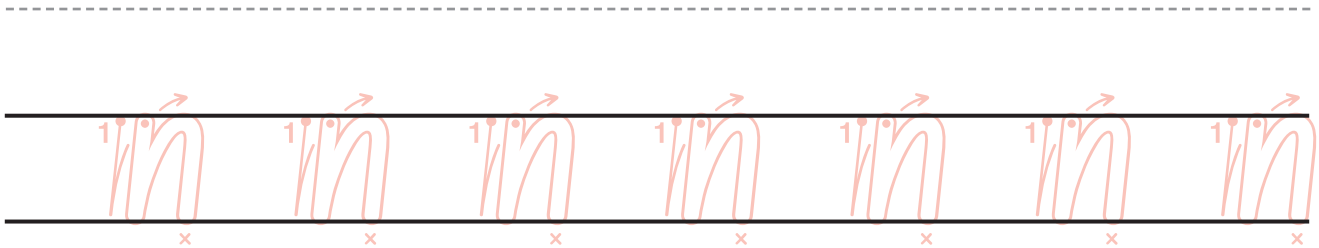

The lower case 'n' is a short letter.

We make a short, straight line and keep our pencil still. We then follow the same line back up. When we are nearly at the top, we make a little wedge and a bump, coming back down to the bottom.



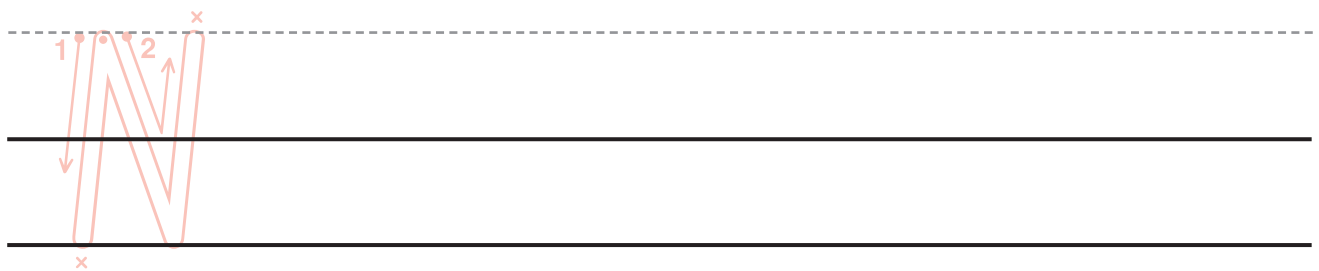
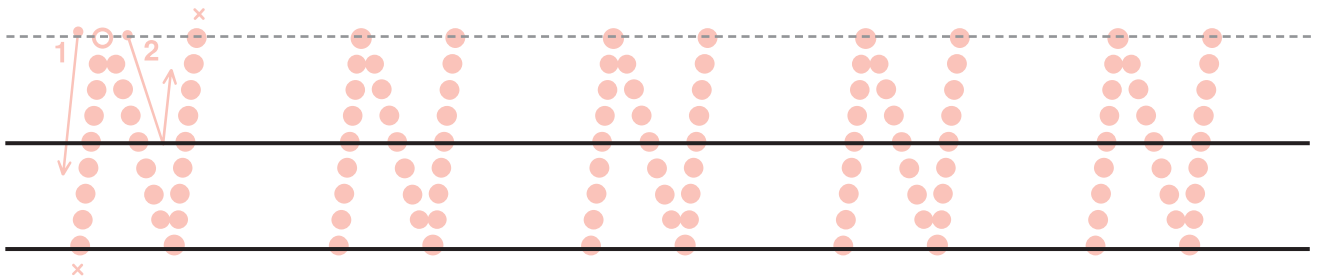
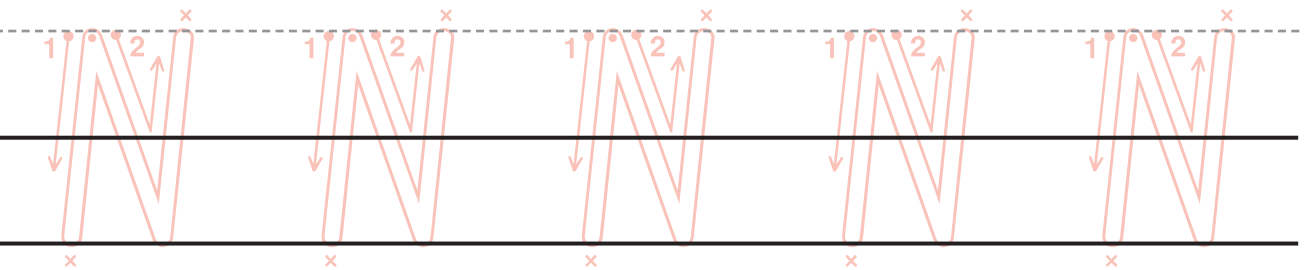
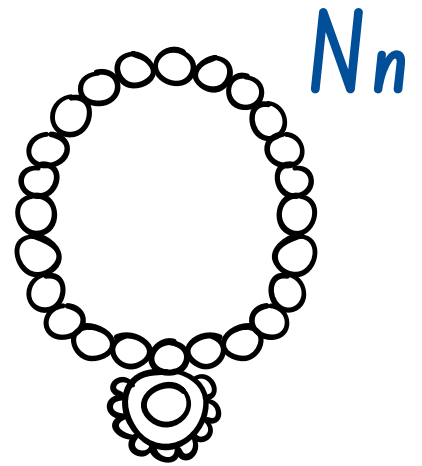
Example mnemonic: Down, up and around!



# Upper case N

The upper case 'N' is a tall letter.

We make a straight line starting at the top and going down. We take our pencil off and make another from the top. Then we keep our pencil on the point at the bottom and make a line going straight up.



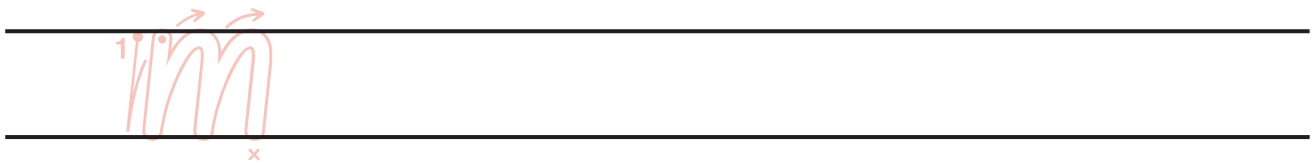
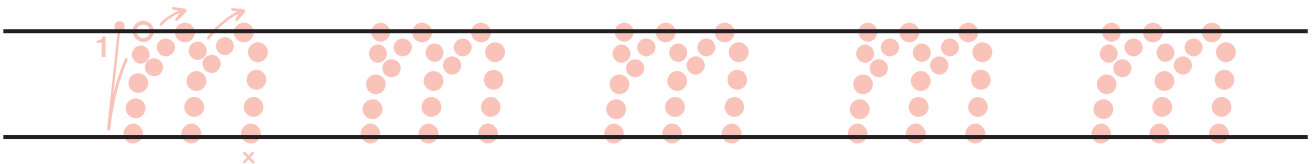
# Lower case m

Mm

The lower case 'm' is a short letter.

We make this letter in one movement. We start by making a short line going down come back up the same line to make a wedge and the first bump. Keeping our pencil still, we head down, back up the same line and make a second bump and follow this to the bottom.

Example mnemonic: Down, up, down, up, down!

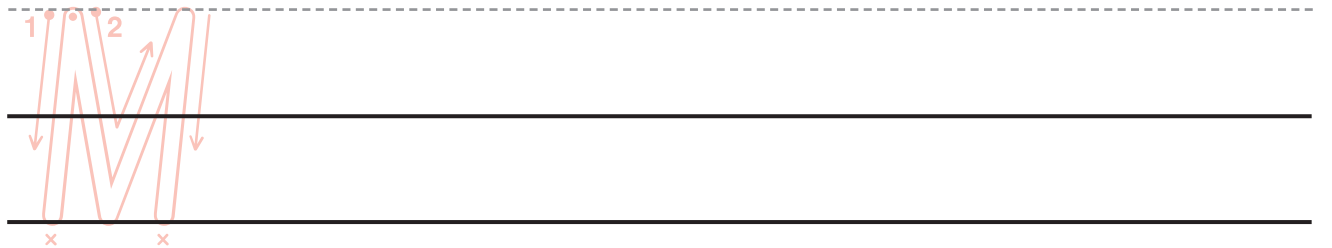
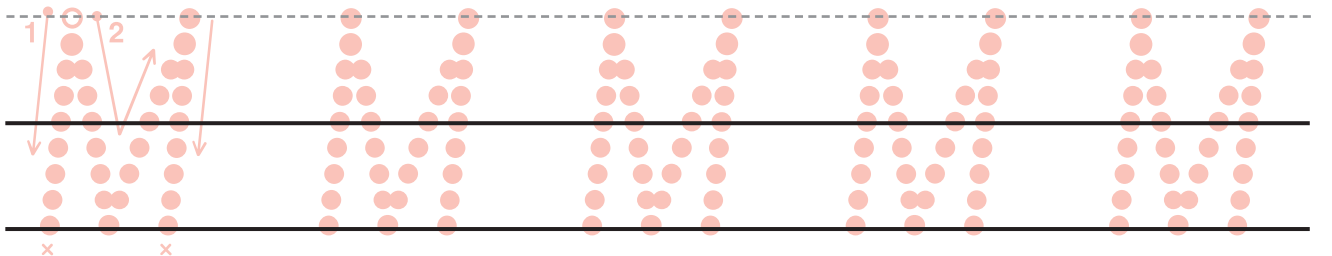
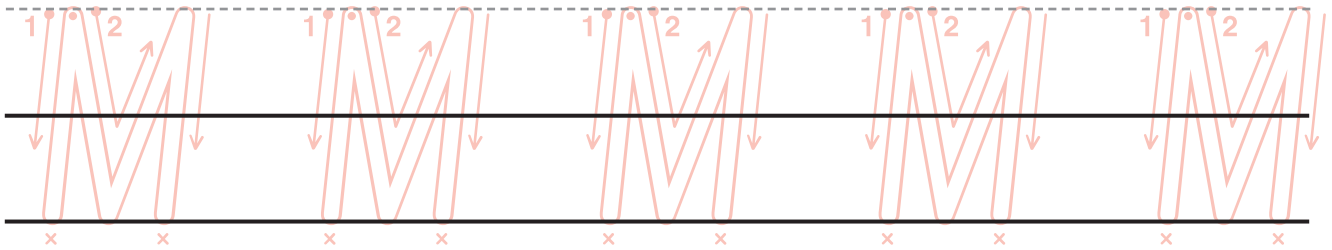


# Upper case M

Mm

The upper case 'M' is a tall letter. We make this letter with two steps. We start at the top and make a straight line. We take our pencil off the paper and draw another line from the top of the first line down to the bottom. We leave our pencil on the page and push back up to the top and then down to the bottom.

Example mnemonic: Down, down, up, down!

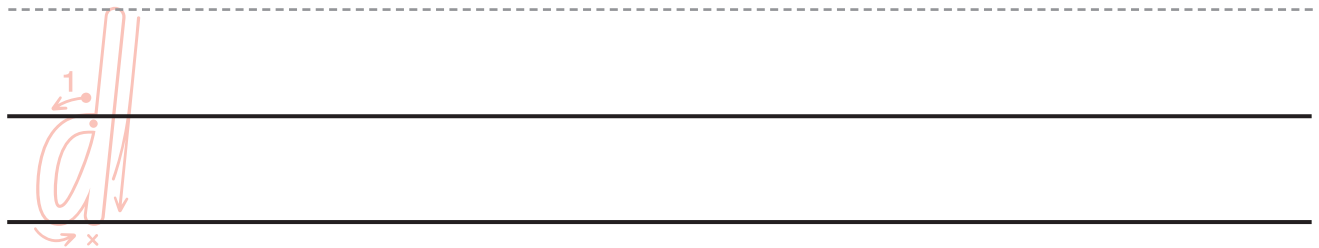
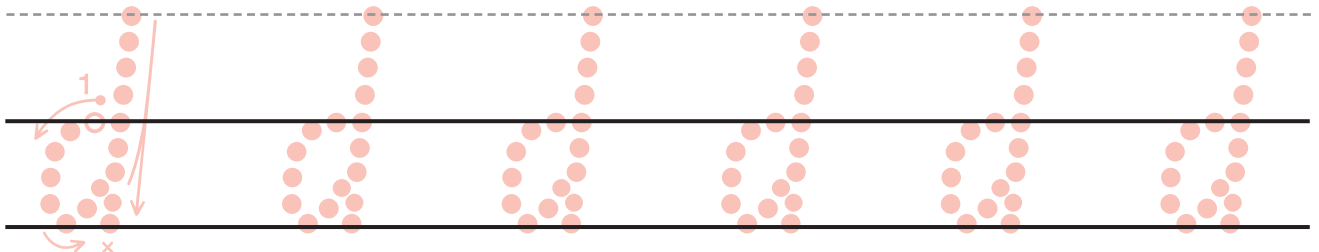
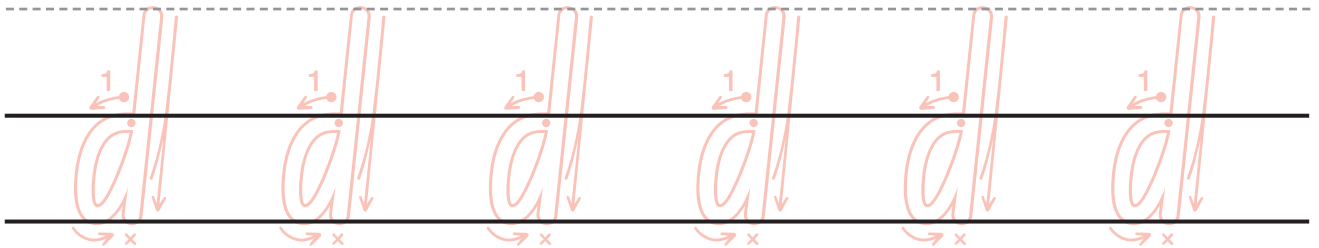


# Lower case d

Dd

The lower case 'd' is a tall letter. We start from the top and make a straight line. We keep the pencil on the line and start to come back up the same line. We make a bump and come back in to the line, leaving a wedge.

Example mnemonic: Down, up, around, in!



# Upper case D

Dd

The upper case 'D' is a tall letter.

We make this letter with two movements. We make a long and straight line. Then we take our pencil off the page and go to the top to make a big curve that meets the bottom of the line.

Example mnemonic: *Down, off and around!*
