


# HSC Strategy School Implementation Pack Term 1 2024

A community of expert and practising HSC teachers, curriculum experts, lead educators and academic partners have contributed to the content in this pack.






#### **Purpose**

- provide resources to support schools implementing HSC Strategy practices.




#### **Plan**

# **High leverage strategies in focus – Part A**

This is the first in a series of four nibbles released in 2024.

#### **Objectives**

- To provide insights into how high leverage strategies help students to more consistently demonstrate the discriminating features of Bands 5 and 6.
- To provide teachers with subjectspecific opportunities to deepen their understanding of the 3 high leverage strategies in focus.
- To build a high trust and appropriately professionally challenging learning environment for Stage 6 teachers to collaborate using HSC Strategy practices.
- To introduce HSC Strategy practices to schools in preparation for participation in HSC Strategy events.

#### **Workshop preparation**


#### Workshop leaders are advised to:


- preview the 'High leverage strategies in focus – Part A' nibble

5 mins	Introduction	Explain the workshop objectives and agenda.	
20 mins	'High leverage strategies in focus – Part A' nibble	<ul> <li>knowledge of high leverage strategies and the discriminating features of the 12 HSC Strategy subjects.</li> <li>understanding of how practising expert HSC teachers select and apply high leverage strategies to promote high student achievement in their Stage 6 classrooms.</li> <li>skills in planning and applying high leverage strategies in classrooms in your own school setting.</li> </ul>	Teachers work through the 'High leverage strategies in focus – Part A' nibble individually on their own device. Teachers respond to questions within the resource and prepare to present their ideas back to a small group.
30 mins	Discussion	Teachers share their responses to consolidate actions to take as next steps.	Workshop leaders position staff in small groups. Teachers each take turns discussing their responses and report their next steps for implementation in their classrooms.
5 mins	Wrap up	To conclude and review the actions to embed the high leverage strategies within classrooms across the school.	Workshop leaders facilitate wrap up and record next steps.


