Summary / Description of course

The Health Support in Schools Training (HSIST) program is designed for school staff who are required to support the health needs of identified students (kindergarten to year 12) in schools. Most frequently, this assistance is provided by Student Learning Support Officers (SLSOs), but there may be other members of the staff (such as supervising teachers) who support or assist, and they are also encouraged to undertake the training, to enable them to provide safe student support, in the school setting and whilst participating in school activities off-site.

The department's Health Support in Schools Training *certification* training is a one day interactive course comprising presentations, demonstrations, reverse demonstration opportunities, and a requirement for participants to demonstrate their understanding of course content. Participants are evaluated for their knowledge and understanding of the course content, before being issued with their certificate. Certificates are valid for 2 years. Participants cannot enrol in a recertification course if they have not attend a certification course in the past.

After completing Health Support in School certification or recertification training, participants will be able to:

- Describe specific roles and responsibilities regarding health support at school
- Describe the process of developing individualised health plans for students and your role in the process
- Understand the components of HSIST
- Reflect on the resources available to support students with health needs in school
- Locate and understand key DoE policies and procedures related to student health support.

The course is co-facilitated by a nurse and a representative from the local Service Delivery team. The course covers the following modules:

- Supporting Students' Health Support Needs, which is related to departmental policies and processes for delivering health support— including the consolidated student health policy, confidentiality, duty of care, legal considerations, industrial considerations
- Infection control, hand hygiene, use of PPE, and spill management
- Enteral (tube feeding)
- Suctioning including tracheostomy care
- Catheter care

In general the departmental facilitator presents the "Supporting students health at school" module of the HSIST course (40-60mins). Then, the nurse facilitator will then use the rest of the day to present the remaining modules, generally presenting 1 before morning tea, 2 between morning tea and lunch, with the final module, and wrap-up being completed after lunch.

Rationale

The Health Support Certification course is designed to provide initial training for school learning support officers who will perform tube feeding, suctioning and/or catheter care procedures for students in schools.
