The NSW Department of Education has partnered with the NSW Department of Communities and Justice to provide students with disability and their families support under the Disability Advocacy Futures Program.

This program supports students with disability and their families to navigate the education and broader service system, and to express their needs to schools.

With this program, we are continuing to build a more inclusive education system, where every student is known, valued and cared for in NSW public schools.



What the program offers

- Students with disability and their families will continue to be encouraged to reach out to their school as the first point of contact. However, they have another avenue of support when encountering complex issues.
- Schools, students with disability and their families can access a free, independent support person to work together when responding to students' educational needs.
- Students with disability and their families can get help to navigate the education and broader service system.
