Counselling and wellbeing support is available and students who are worried or upset are encouraged to talk to the school counsellor or their teachers.

We ask that you talk to your children at home about any concerns they may have at this time and remind them that our school is a safe space which promotes respect for all people. Please contact the school if you have any concerns so that we may work together to ensure that all our students feel safe and well supported.

If you need an interpreter, please call the Telephone Interpreter Service on 131 450 and ask for an interpreter in your language. Tell the operator the phone number you want to call, and they will get an interpreter on the line to help you with your conversation. You will not be charged for this service.
