

Student access to NSW EduChat

Information for parents and carers

NSW EduChat is a generative artificial intelligence tool owned and designed by the NSW Department of Education. It is designed to be safe, educational, secure and private.

Student access to NSW EduChat

Students in Year 5 to Year 12 will gain access to NSW EduChat in Term 4, 2025.

Safety of students using NSW EduChat

NSW EduChat data is secured. All data stays within the department. This means that students can input their work and personal identifying information safely into NSW EduChat.

Educational design of NSW EduChat

NSW EduChat does not simply provide the full answers to questions. It responds to students by asking open-ended questions. This encourages students to explore and share their thoughts and reasoning. NSW EduChat only uses text. This means it cannot produce media such as pictures, video or music.

Using NSW EduChat for help with homework and assessment tasks

If schools advise that NSW EduChat can be used for homework or assessments, students should notify their teachers if they have used NSW EduChat in completing tasks. This includes using NSW EduChat for tasks such as, but not limited to, summarising study notes, definition of key terms or structuring text. Schools should communicate the ways in which students can reasonably notify their teachers.

Access to NSW EduChat at home

Students can access NSW EduChat at home through:

Students will need to log in using their NSW Department of Education login. Only the student who logged in should use NSW EduChat.
