How does the NSW School Infrastructure Cadetship work?

- School Infrastructure NSW is a part of the NSW Department of Education. We build new schools and undertake major upgrades to existing schools.
- Our teams work across several business areas, including infrastructure planning and project delivery, procurement, sustainability, IT and digital services, and asset management.
- The program combines practical work experience in your field while you complete your studies.
- Cadets get up to two years' experience working in School Infrastructure NSW, with a work program built around their existing study schedules.
- The Cadetship program commences in March 2024.

Eligibility criteria

You are eligible to apply for this program if you are:

- under 25 years of age
- in the second last or last year of a bachelor degree or last year of a diploma
- undertaking studies in Engineering, Project Management, Planning, Property, Information Technology/Computer Science, Sustainability, Procurement, Business or related areas.
