About the rogram

- Under the program, SINSW will recruit graduates in the following directorates: Service Planning, Infrastructure Planning, Infrastructure Delivery, Technical Services, Asset Activations, Business Enablement, and Asset Management.
- Graduates will participate in a six-month internal rotation to grow their capability.
- The two year Graduate Program commences in March 2024.

Eligibility criteria

You are eligible to apply for this program if you are:

- a recent graduate with a diploma, undergraduate or postgraduate degree completed within the last two years or by December 2023.
- undertaking or have completed studies in Engineering, Project Management, Planning, Property, Information Technology, Computer Science, Sustainability, Procurement, Business or related areas.
- an Australian or New Zealand citizen, Australian permanent resident or hold a valid working visa.
