Millennium is a web-based, integrated school and student management system. Flexible design and simple to use, Millennium makes teaching easier.

What data is collected?

Millennium contains personal data such as student information and staff information.

This information includes, but is not limited to, first and last names, unique identifiers, phone, email, address, allergies/medical, academic results, wellbeing information, attendance data, timetables, calendars, and other school defined data.

How is the data used?

The data stored in Millennium is used by the school to manage and support students and staff, and aid in day to day operations.

This includes tasks such as managing attendance, reporting on academic performance, aid in teaching and learning, and general management of the school.

Is the data secure?

Millennium is committed to the protection of data in alignment with privacy principles, and providing a secure and safe working environment for staff, students and parents.

Your Personal Information is stored in a manner that reasonably protects it from misuse and loss and from unauthorised access, modification or disclosure.

When is the data deleted?

Data is deleted at the request of the school Principal or in alignment with privacy obligations.

Where is the data?

All data is stored in a secure data centre in Sydney, Australia.
