



## Digital Careers Toolbox

### What is it?

The Digital Careers Toolbox is a new resource designed to help students identify careers and courses for when they finish high school.

It contains three of the best digital tools available to help them identify their strengths and passions and match them with a career.

With a focus on careers rather than a higher education (university) or vocational education and training (eg TAFE) courses, it'll help students make better informed choices about occupations which suit their personalities, likes and preferences.

It also shows them which courses they could take to get the skills they need to do that job.

### What's in it?

**LifeLauncher** helps students get started by doing quizzes, exploring over 5,000 course and career options, organise research and get the right amount of information. It can be used as a conversation starter or to locate a local tertiary education provider. With bite-sized information, students can use this on-the-go or at home – in fact, anywhere on any device.

**Myfuture** assists students to explore the career or industry they might want to work in. It also provides in-depth information and tailored support for career advisors, teachers and parents. It's also full of inspirational stories, guides and articles to help students stay on track – or even get started.

### SkillsRoad 360 Virtual Workplace

immerses students into different workplaces. Through personal stories filmed in a workplace setting, students can will get a more human feel for what working is like. As an immersive tool, it can be used with a virtual reality headset to really dive in. The videos can also be experienced through a desktop, laptop or tablet device.

### Can anybody use it?

Yes. The website is free to use and available to anyone.

As a parent you can explore all three sites, or dip in and out of the sites and sections which most interest you. It can certainly be a conversation starter for you and your child.

As a job seeker, you can also use the toolbox the same way school students use it – help with identifying career options you may not have thought about, useful information about hundreds of industries, and a way to identify and locate a course that you can do to get the skills you need to do the job you want.
