

Principal Facilitators

Experienced, successful leaders play a pivotal role in supporting the leadership development of colleagues at all stages of their career.

The School Leadership Institute (SLI) offers experienced NSW public school principals the opportunity to deepen their practice and contribute to system leadership through the Principal Facilitator role.

Principal Facilitators support current and aspiring leaders in select SLI programs and induction conferences throughout the school year.

Expressions of interest are regularly advertised through Staff Noticeboard.

What is the commitment of Principal Facilitators?

Principal Facilitators will:

- Attend facilitator training
- Attend face-to-face or online professional learning alongside program participants
- Engage in online learning activities as part of the training and preparation for each session
- Facilitate small group learning of approximately 1:5 ratio with ongoing communication

What is the role of Principal Facilitators?

- Support the learning of school leaders through small group facilitation and individual guidance
- Participate in quality professional learning delivered by experts in leadership development
- Examine research regarding adult learning and effective collaborative professional learning
- Engage in collaborative networks with other school leaders, system leaders and university partners.

When will Principal Facilitator training occur?

If successful, Principal Facilitators will be required to attend training workshops as well as participate in additional online activities.

Successful Principal Facilitator applicants will be notified and initial online training will occur prior to the programs commencing.

How to apply

Applicants must:

- Complete an online EOI form
- Gain endorsement from your Director, Educational Leadership (DEL) and provide their contact details as they will be your referee

Applicants are also required to provide a one-page career history, plus a one-page written response addressing the following criteria:

1. Demonstrated knowledge and capacity to facilitate the leadership development of colleagues
2. Demonstrated contribution to, and impact on the learning of others beyond the school within the NSW public education system

Submissions

Selection process

A panel consisting of an Executive Director; Director, Educational Leadership; Director, SLI and a current primary and secondary principal will assess applications and make recommendations.

Funding

Principal Facilitators will be eligible for casual relief to reimburse their school while they attend training and seminars.
