# Community Engagement

## Learning Circle Overview

The Community Engagement Learning Circle will focus on strengthening meaningful community engagement through authentic partnerships with Aboriginal families, Elders, community organisations, and local services.

Local teams across the state will lead high-impact professional learning that is contextualised to their community, creating rich and culturally responsive learning experiences for school staff. The day will support educators to deepen their knowledge of local services, understand culturally appropriate protocols for connection, and build the confidence to engage respectfully with Aboriginal communities.

Participants will

- Understand the importance of authentic community engagement in improving educational outcomes for Aboriginal students
- Develop a deeper understanding of culturally responsive practices that strengthen relationships with Aboriginal students, families and local communities
- Explore practical strategies to create culturally inclusive classrooms where Aboriginal students feel valued, respected and connected.
- Strengthen confidence to engage respectfully with local Aboriginal communities, recognising the importance of partnership and shared decision-making
- Identify ways to meaningfully include Aboriginal voices, perspectives and knowledge within classroom learning and school decision-making.
