Note to keyboard - treble

Note to keyboard - treble

Draw a line from the treble clef note on the staff, to its position on the keyboard. The first one is done for you. Remember that there is more than one of each letter name. The higher they are on the staff, the higher (further to the right from middle C) they are on the keyboard.
