





Some new note values are included in this fabulous little tune.



- 1. What is the definition of a **sequence**?
- 2. Put a square around the three consecutive bars that contain a sequence.
- 3. Complete the box below, indicating how many beats each note receives.



Some new note values are included in this fabulous little tune.



The pattern of notes in the first three bars is called a sequence. A **sequence** is a set of notes that are repeated (consecutively) at a higher or lower pitch. Notice that the order of notes in bars two and three are the same as bar one, they just begin on a higher note in each bar.
