



Listening in drama

7 strategies for Stage 4, 5 or 6



Key words & terminology

Identify key words and drama terminology used in listening examples such as radio plays, videos and monologues.



Delivery & tone of voice

Discuss and respond to how the delivery and tone of voice contributed to the meaning of a dramatic piece, script or performance?



Recall

After a performance, discuss which lines were the most important. Get students to recall them.



Active listening

Discuss and explore the movement of a character demonstrating active listening.



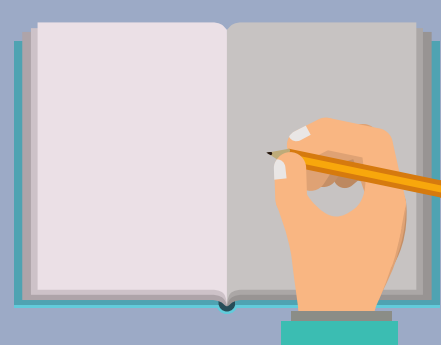
Structure

Identify and respond to the narrative structure of a listening example.



Innovate

Read a scene or play to the class. Students should then innovate/playbuild a new ending.



Rephrase

Rephrase or summarise information delivered to the class from a source about your current unit of study.
