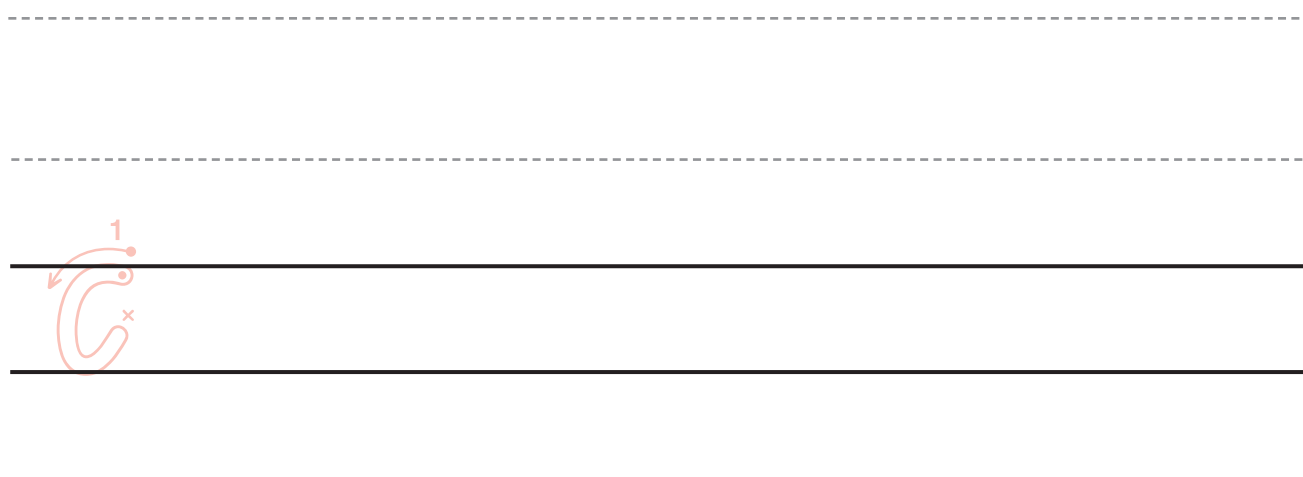
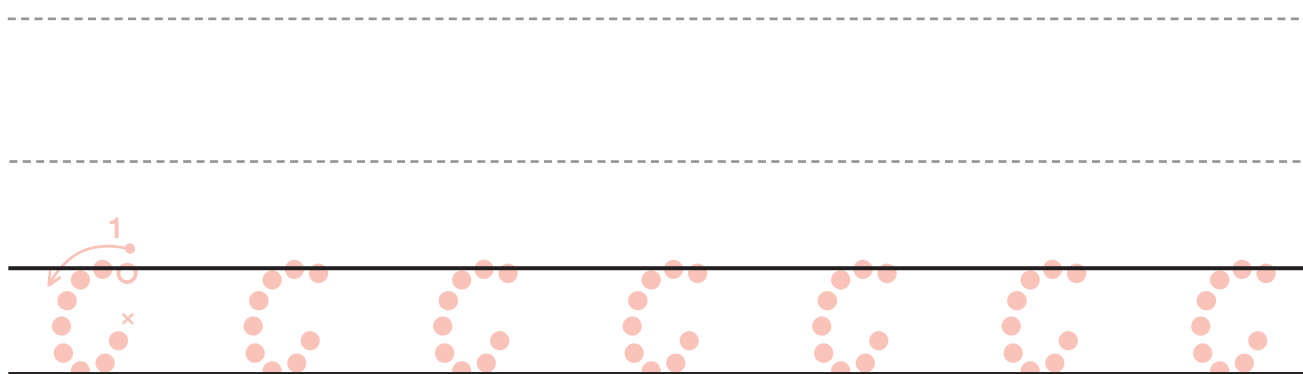
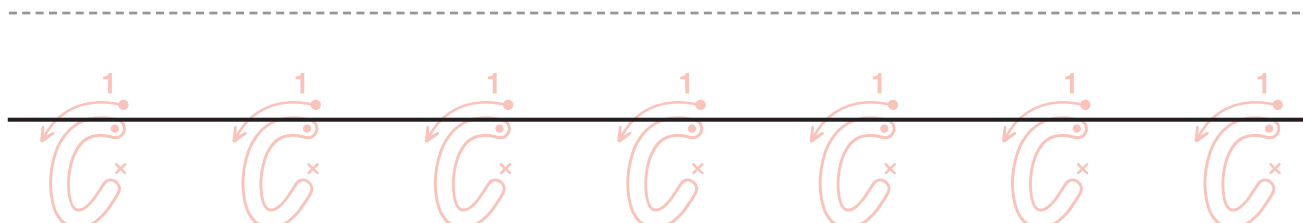
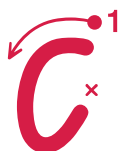


# Lower case c

The lower case 'c' is a short letter.  
When we write this letter, we start  
at the top and gently curl to the left.

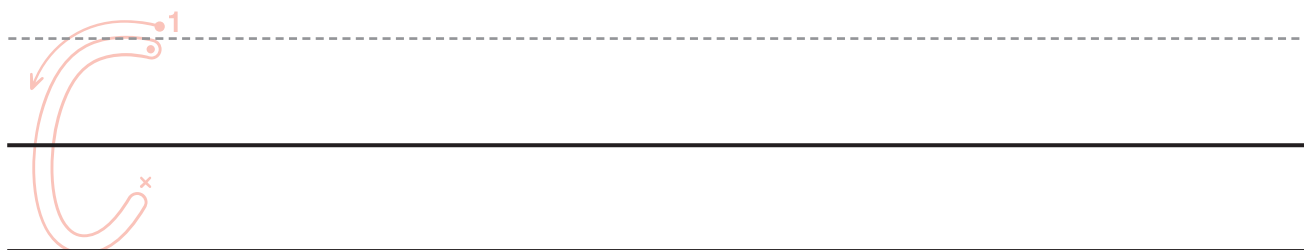
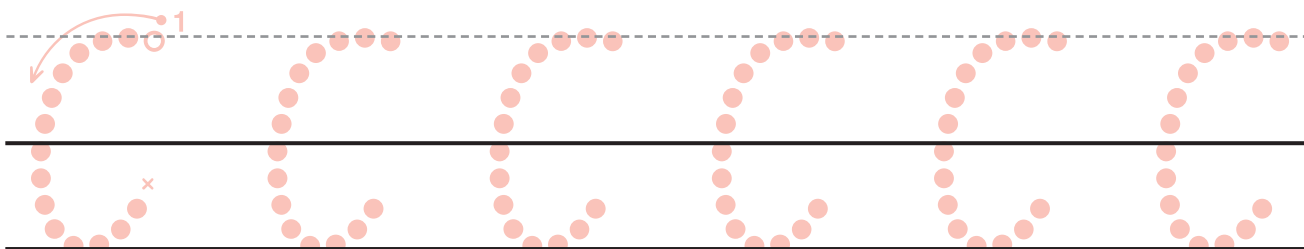
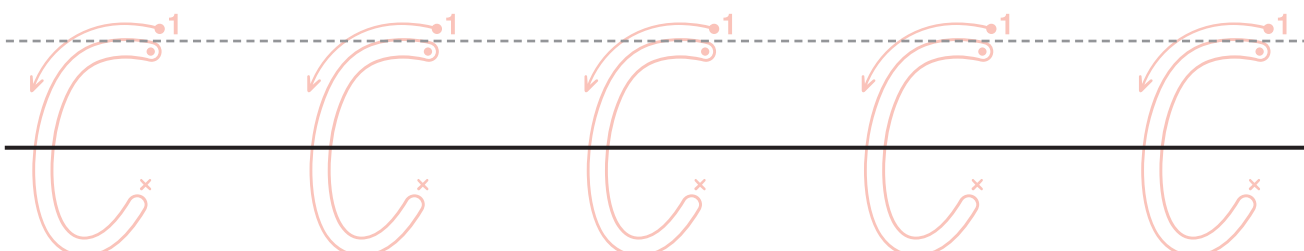
Example mnemonic: Curve it to the left!



# Upper case C

The upper case 'C' is a tall letter.  
When we write this letter, we start at the top and gently curl to the left. It is the same as the lower case 'c' but taller.

Example mnemonic: Curve it to the left!

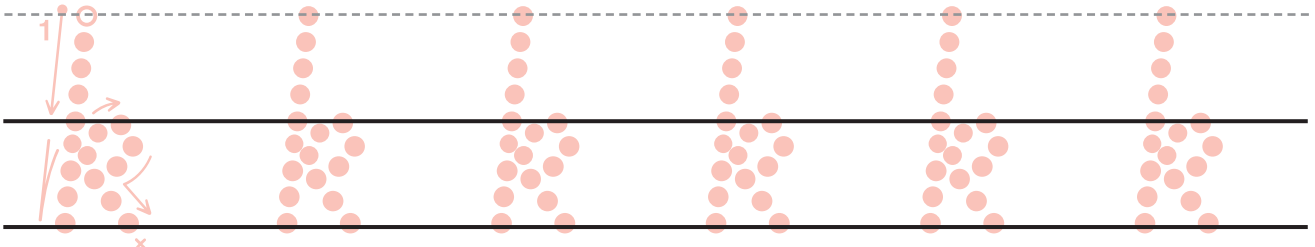
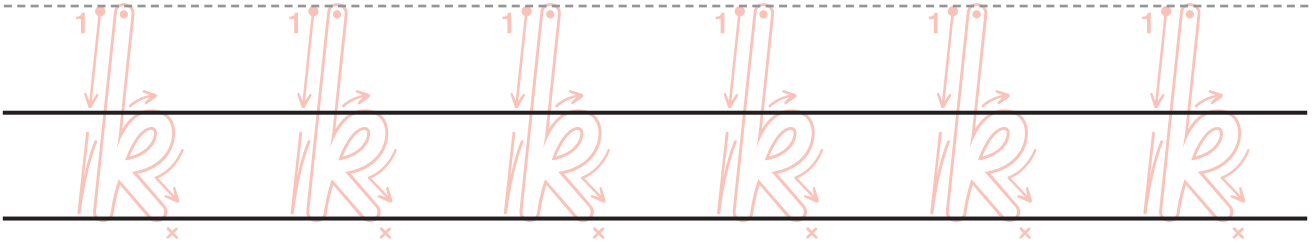


# Lower case k

The lower case 'k' is a tall letter.

When we write this letter, we start tall, move straight down, back up to the guide line, loop it and stretch the line horizontally.

Example mnemonic: Start tall, down, loop and kick!



# Upper case K

Kk

The upper case 'K' is a tall letter.  
When we write this letter, we start tall, move straight down. We take our pen off the page and start at the top again with a line that slopes into the straight line then slopes away again.

Example mnemonic: Start tall, down. Slope down left, then right !
