
Lower case g


The lower case 'g' is a long letter.


When we write this letter we start at the guide line, circle around and dip below the guides to form a hook.

The upper case 'G' is a tall letter. We start at the top and do a big curve to the left. We stop on our way back up before we get to the guide line, then we do a short straight line down. Example mnemonic: Curve it to the left, then straight down!

Lower case The lower case 'o' is a short letter. When we write this letter we start at the top, create a full loop and return to the start. Example mnemonic: All the way around, back to the start!
