Gi

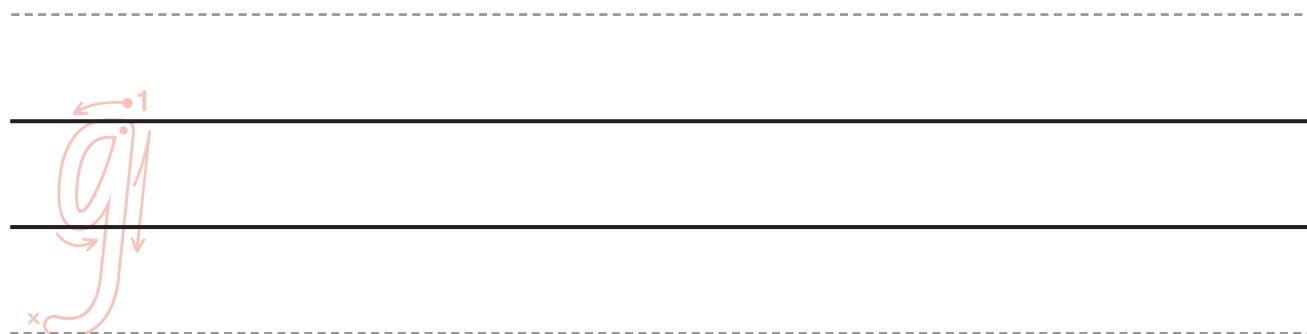
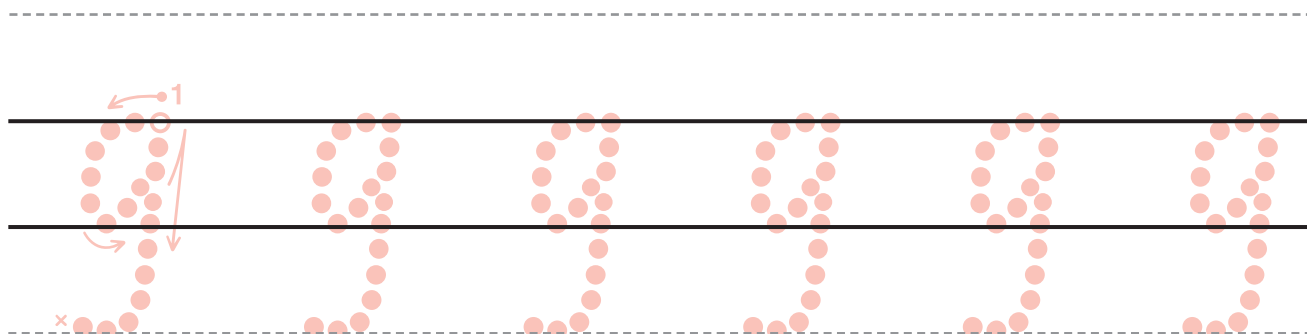


The lower case 'g' is a long letter.

When we write this letter we start at the guide line, circle around and dip below the guides to form a hook.



Example mnemonic: Around and a hook!



# Upper case G

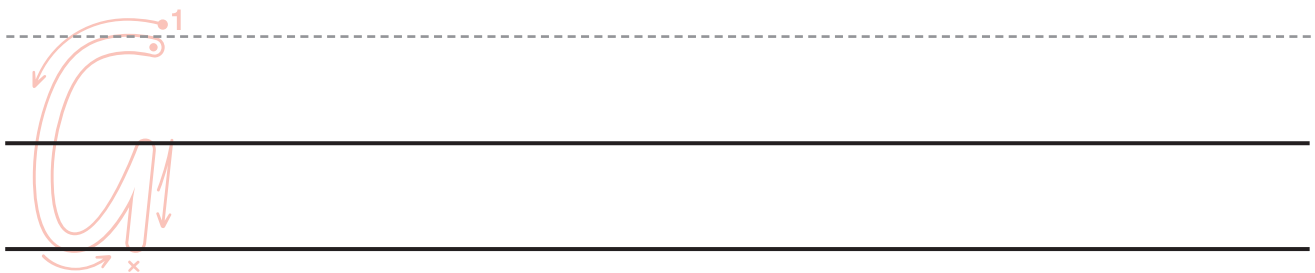
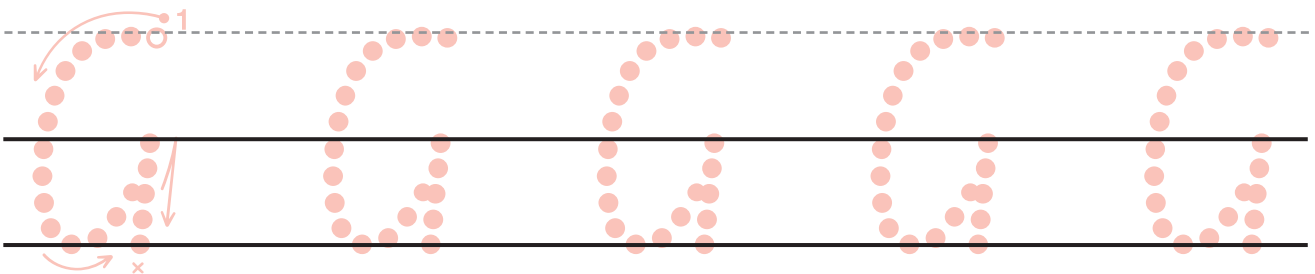
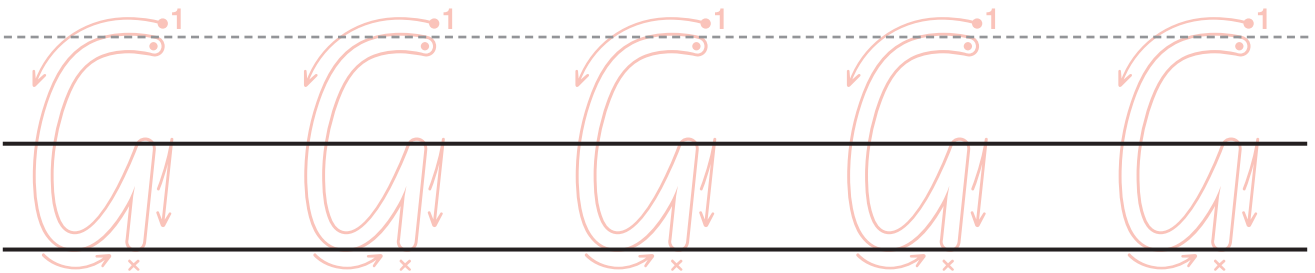
The upper case 'G' is a tall letter.

We start at the top and do a big curve to the left. We stop on our way back up before we get to the guide line, then we do a short straight line down.

Example mnemonic: Curve it to the left, then straight down!

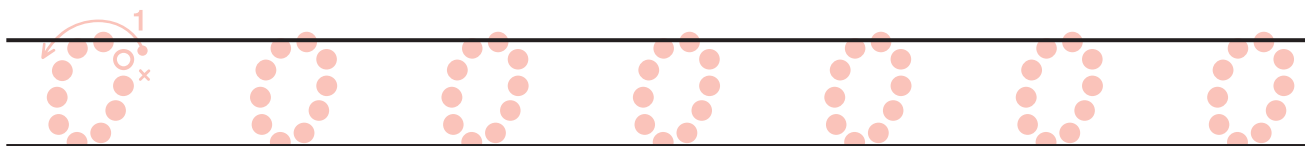
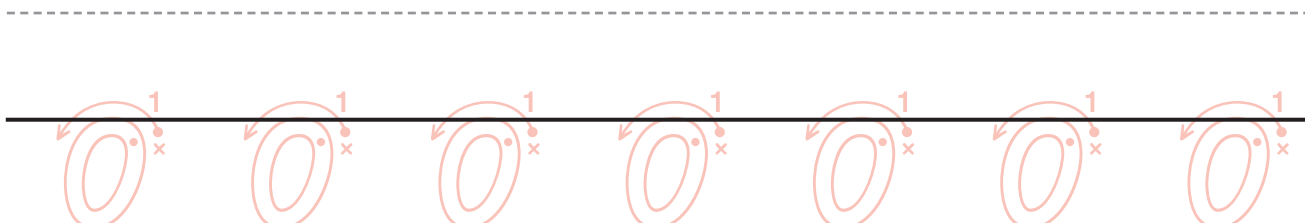
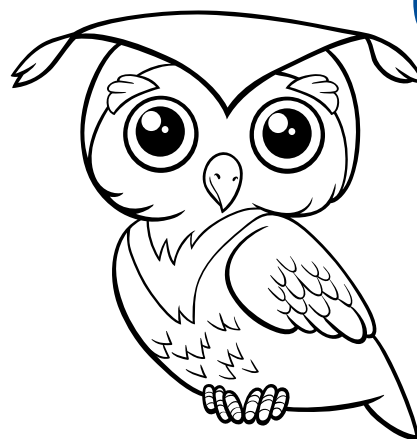


# Lower case o

Oo

The lower case 'o' is a short letter.  
When we write this letter we start at the top,  
create a full loop and return to the start.

Example mnemonic: All the way around,  
back to the start!



# Upper case O

The upper case 'O' is a tall letter.  
When we write this letter, we start at the top, create a full loop and return to the start. It is the same as the lower case 'o' but taller.

Example mnemonic: All the way around, back to the start!
