Viewing the virtual reality (VR) immersion experience is most effective with a small group of colleagues.

Information to consider before commencing the experience

Review <u>Lithgow Public School lesson overview</u> Based on this information and the school context, what do you think the learning in this VR experience will look like? Consider the space, communication, <u>learning modes</u>, and the role of the teachers and students.

Pause and discuss the following questions during the experience

- How are teachers using minimal resources (desks and chairs) to ensure every student has space to learn?
- What changes to your practice(s) may you need to make to transition to an innovative learning environment?

What possibilities and challenges could arise if you implemented the teaching and learning strategies from this immersion experience, in your own context?
