## Who is this resource for?

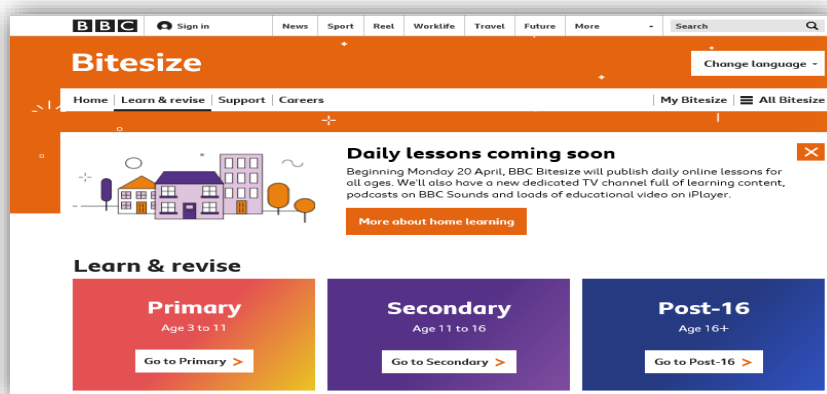
BBC Bitesize is a free online study support resource designed to help with learning, revision and homework.

Bitesize provides support for learners aged 5 to 16+ across a wide range of school subjects. It also supports children and young people's wellbeing and career choices. From April 20th Bitesize will be publishing daily lessons to help students with learning from home.




- Games, phonics support
