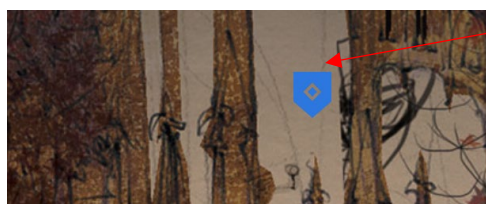
Who is this resource for?
