Workshops for school networks



A co-designed series of 3 workshops exploring key aspects of the policy, including the HIPL model. These workshops will incorporate opportunities for collaboration, planning and reflection. Specific content and activities are co-designed with network representatives.

Purpose – Develop a deep understanding of the professional learning policy, the HIPL model and supporting resources whilst reflecting on existing practice and planning for strategic implementation within school.

High Impact Professional Learning alignment workshops



Workshops that span a 4-week period with an initial 1-hour discovery workshop that includes a team reflection on how work aligns to the HIPL model. This is followed up by a 45-minute playback session to review findings, answer questions and finalise a personalised HIPL alignment summary.

Purpose – To explore the HIPL model, identify connections to existing practice and opportunities for refinement.

Information sessions



A co-designed 1-2 hour session that introduces the key aspects of the Professional Learning Policy. The session includes two opportunities for audience interaction through discussion and activities.

Purpose – Introduce key aspects of the professional learning policy and provide an overview of implementation support for use in establishing or enhancing high impact professional learning environments in schools.
