Pre-placement Questionnaire.

One way to improve the quality of a professional experience placement is to use information about the pre-service teacher (PST) to help differentiate and structure the practicum.

Who implements this strategy

Professional Experience Coordinator (PEXC) or Supervisor (ST)

How is it implemented?

- When a school receives an email from a University about a professional experience placement, the PEXC or ST attaches the preplacement questionnaire to the reply email.
- The PEXC or ST will ask the PST to complete the questionnaire and returned it via email to their ST by a specific date.
- The ST will use this information to help organise the placement and align their expectations. For example, this could be based on the number of previous placements, their interests and strengths and the PSTs goals for this practicum.
- The ST will consider and implement other 'high impact' strategies that will support the PST professional experience goals.



Variations:

- Arrange for an online meeting or phone call prior to placement and ask these or similar key questions.
- Vary the questions asked. Adjust or select from the questions to best suit your situation/school.

What are the benefits of implementing this strategy?

- Supports a strength based approach as it allows the ST to focus on the PSTs abilities, knowledge and skills.
- The PST has a feeling of control over their professional development.
- The ST understands the PSTs previous work and classroom experiences and can position their expectations to match.
- ST have the opportunity to consider mentoring techniques and high impact strategies prior to placement.

Outcomes

- The placement is differentiate to meet the professional development needs of the PST, allowing them to feel known, valued and cared about.
- The strength based approach benefits the students and school.

Success indicators

- An indicator that the strategy is working as intended: the placement is
 differentiate to meet the current professional development needs of the
 PST. There is a smooth transition from pre placement into Week 1 of the
 placement. There are opportunities created to see other classrooms.
- An indicator that the strategy is not working as intended: The ST has limited information about the PST prior to placement and it takes a few days into the placement to understand their current professional development needs.
