

NSW Training Awards 2024

Awards process for individual award categories

What happens after you are nominated?

1

Entry Phase

Your entry will be assessed by your (allocated) Training Awards region based on the criteria. If your application is successful, you will be invited for an interview within your region



2

Regional Level Phase

If you are successful and selected as a regional finalist for your award category, you will be invited to the NSW Training Awards regional event in June where the winner of your category will be announced.



3

If you are announced as the regional winner of your category, you will progress to the next stage where you will represent your region and be invited for a state interview (mid July) in Sydney.



4

State Level Phase

The NSW Training Awards team will advise the outcome of the interview by phone or letter.

If you are successful and selected as a state finalist, you will be invited to attend the NSW Training Awards presentation event in September.



5

If you are announced as the winner of your category, you will be invited to the best professional development week in Sydney. This is in preparation for the Australian Training Awards.

6

National Level Phase

As the NSW State winner in your category, you will interview for the Australian Training Awards and progress to represent NSW in December for 'Finalist Week'. All national finalists are invited to the presentation dinner during 'Finalist Week' where the winner will be announced.

Flights and accommodation will be covered by the Australian Training Awards.

(please note that the VET in Schools Student award does not progress to the National Level, this is a NSW only category)
